



THE PROVERSE PRIZE 2014

At the Proverse Spring Reception, 9 April 2015, held in Central Hong Kong, Dr Verner Bickley, MBE, Co-Founder of the international Proverse Prize for unpublished writing, announced the winners in the 2014 competition.

First, Dr Bickley reported that, as in previous years, entries were received from around the world and the standard was very high. Again the judges had had difficulty in selecting a single winner. Once again, there are joint-winners of the Proverse Prize.

They are: Celia Claase for a collection of philosophical essays and poems and Philip Chatting for a collection of short stories. Celia is from South Africa and Philip from the UK. Both live now in Hong Kong.

Supplementary Prizes may be announced later in the year.

It is hoped that these winning books will be launched in November this year (2015).
